Lessons Learned in Creation

Like many of you, I am currently basking in the Creation as the seasons change from freezing cold to sunny and warm.

Recently, I stood on Whipple Beach in Baxter and just took time to observe the sunset. The sky was colored orange and pink, and the light brilliantly shone off the water. In that moment, I understood how God could look on the sun and the stars, evening and morning at the beginning of creation and say, "Yep, this will do just fine."

While I was filming this beautiful sight, something flew through the frame. I figured since there was still plenty of time before the sun officially set, I could take a few minutes to look for what it was.

Turning, I found a Ring-Billed Gull sitting on top of one of the park buildings.

If you don't recognize this bird by its name, you may know it instead by its loud, screechy call, or you've probably seen hordes of them in fast-food parking lots, looking for those fries you dropped. In fact, these birds are known for hanging around landfills as one of their favorite places to get a meal.

Not really the same majestic image conjured up by that sunset, is it?

Still, as I observed the gull peering down from its perch above Whipple Beach, I couldn't help but look through the zoomed in shot of it on my camera as it groomed its white and grey feathers. And at that time I thought I could see how God looked at the first Ring-Billed Gull he ever made and say, "Yep, this too will do just fine."

This thought has been reinforced after doing some followup research on the gulls. I learned these gulls are, according to the American Bird Conservancy, "Model Parents." Two gulls will typically mate for life, find an area safe to raise their young alongside other gulls and



work together to ensure their chicks are fed, safe, and grow.

Having seen pictures, I can assure you that is a much more flattering image for these birds.

Once again, God taught me wonderful lessons through spending time in the Creation. The first is to look for the good in all things. The second is to not take one look at something and think you can judge it entirely.

And maybe one of the reasons I did not like looking at those gulls in the parking lots of fast food or hovering around landfills is that it drew attention to some unattractive human behaviors, namely littering and waste in general.

Still, just like with those birds, we are not defined soley by our mistakes. I hope that God has a plan for all of us that involves us making some positive difference in the world. And, I like to think that just like all the other creations He has made, when God looked at us when we were born He said, "Yep, this too will do just fine."

"It takes a village...." That's a phrase we hear often. And it does take a village to meet many of our community's needs. One of those many needs is the lack of decent, affordable housing. There is a coalition in the Brainerd area that is attempting to meet some of that need. The My Neighbor to Love Coalition has come together to create housing and supportive services to ultimately meet the needs of from 18-36 people. Construction has started on Phase I of this plan. Creekside Community will have four small 400 sf studio apartments. Born of the belief that all people deserve safe, affordable housing, Vicky Kinney has led the efforts to get this project off the ground.

What can you do to help? Financial support is definitely welcome. This project does not involve using any state or federal funds. But there are other ways to help. There is a need for folks with experience sheetrocking. Other projects include laying flooring, painting and landscaping and they are willing to teach! Later, there will be opportunities to volunteer to be a supportive friend of the people who will be the first occupants.

These are the seeds that help combat homelessness and poverty. This is the way to be part of a village that cares for its own. The area lost the New Pathways Program for families in 2019. A warming shelter to help during the winter months has helped fill one gap. But there is much more to do if we are going to find permanent solutions.

Vicky Kinney will be coming to Lord of Life to provide more information on this new, exciting venture in our community. 
