FORWARD TOGETHER: DEBT-FREE AND MISSION FOCUSED

"Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law." — Romans 13:8 (NIV)

Eliminating our debt will free Lord of Life to dream God-sized dreams for the future.

Right now, we dedicate \$3,316 per month—nearly \$68,000 per year—toward our \$580,000 mortgage. Imagine the impact if those funds were directed entirely to ministry.

Without mortgage payments, we could:

- Invest in children and family ministry
- Expand mission trip opportunities for youth and adults
- Nurture a culture of grace and generosity
- O Dream even bigger for what God has in store

The opportunity to pay off our debt is within reach, and together, we can make it happen. Imagine the joy of knowing that every dollar given goes directly to mission and ministry.

These improvements will allow us to expand our programming and continue providing a safe, nurturing, and faith-filled environment for the next generation.

Together, we can ensure our facilities reflect our mission and serve our children and youth for years to come.

From our first days as a ministry, Lord of Life Lutheran Church has reached out to welcome all. As we meet our challenge goal for the capital campaign, Lord of Life will work to eliminate barriers that limit accessibility in our space.

Power-assisted entry doors will make it easy for everyone to enter our community of faith and worship and learn together.

Improving the sound system will allow all people to fully engage in worship, both in-person and online. A consultant will educate us on the most impactful steps to take, which could include screens, speakers, sound-dampening systems, assistive technology, and/or soundboards. Not to mention a more user-friendly system will expand the pool of volunteers able to help out during worship.

As Lord of Life steps Forward Together, we will ensure that our space welcomes all.

FORWARD TOGETHER: OUR COMMITMENT

Please prayerfully consider joining hands with others in the *Forward Together* campaign.

Our first goal is to raise \$660,000 to move forward together, debt-free and to enhance our spaces for our children and youth.

When we accomplish that, we propose a \$190,000 challenge goal (for a total of \$850,000) to move forward together to welcome all to this space we have loved so well for 30 years.

We can reach this goal as we each do our part. Prayerfully consider your capacity to give to help our community of faith to move forward together.

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When do my gift payments for the campaign begin?

Unless you prefer a different timetable, the payment period begins April 2025. The Intent Form allows you to specify how and when you plan to fulfill your commitment.

How long does the Forward Together campaign last?

The campaign runs for three years, from April 2025 to March 2028. However, if extending your giving period allows you to make a larger gift, you are welcome to do so. You may also choose to give a one-time gift or make payments for a shorter duration.

For those aged 73 or older, donating through an IRA Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) can be a strategic way to make a significant contribution at a time that works best for you.

Is it possible just to make gifts to the Campaign without making a specific commitment?

Yes, but submitting a Statement of Intent—while not legally binding—helps us plan for the future impact of our ministry. Every response, even without a formal commitment, strengthens our shared vision and demonstrates our congregation's dedication to new and expanded ministry opportunities.

Do all gifts to the *Forward Together* campaign have to be cash?

No. You may give in various ways, including:

- Property
- Appreciated stocks or mutual funds
- Cash value from life insurance policies or policy loan proceeds
- ▶ Certificates of Deposit (CDs), bonds, or annuities

Because certain gifts may have tax implications or restrictions, we encourage you to consult your financial advisor.

What is the advantage of giving appreciated stocks or property?

By giving appreciated stocks or property, you can avoid capital gains taxes and receive a charitable tax deduction.

Important: If donating stocks or property, do not sell them yourself, as you may be subject to capital gains taxes. Instead, let Lord of Life or your financial professional help structure the transaction for maximum benefit.

How do I make a gift of appreciated stock?

Your broker can transfer shares from your account to the church.

Important: Do not sell the stock yourself, or you may be unable to avoid capital gains tax. The church's broker will sell the stock, and you will receive a deductible credit based on the average market value on the day the stock is transferred.

Will I be asked to give a specific amount?

You will be asked to prayerfully consider an amount based on the Gifts Needed Chart on page 6 to reach our goal. If every gift is fulfilled, we can exceed our goal.
