Discovering How to be an Artful Listener

In a recent Brainerd Dispatch article, I shared a story about this past May, when our youngest daughter graduated from Florida State University. While the campus buzzed with excitement and joy, it was also heavy with the grief of loss and violence. Two weeks before the end of the academic year, a young man opened fire in the student union, killing two men and injuring a number of students. The shooting happened on a Thursday. Maundy Thursday, to be exact. A vigil was held the following evening and then a notice went out on Sunday from the University's President to the entire faculty and student body that classes would resume on Monday and the academic year would move to its natural close.

However, at our daughter's commencement, the president stood before the student body, faculty and an auditorium full of parents and family and humbly confessed his error in judgment. He shared that by Monday morning his "inbox" was overloaded with the cries, pleas, and questions of the student body. They weren't ready to walk back onto

He implored the graduates and those gathered to stay open to having their minds changed and to be willing to accept and receive wisdom in even the most unexpected ways. I left inspired to listen more deeply to the world around me.

It is a process of listening - listening for things that have brought joy to you in being part of a community of faith, to the things that have been frustrating to you in this community of faith, to the things you'd like to change and the things you'd like to see in this community of faith.
